### Notes;

The first fire alarm boxes in South Boston were numbered using the District / Station number system.

On April 28, 1864, two and three digit numbers were introduced. Numbers in the low 100 series were assigned to boxes in South Boston.

Due to the lack of numbers for new boxes, duplicate box numbers were introduced in 1875.

A new four digit number system was introduced in 1914. Numbers in the new 7100 series were assigned to fire boxes in South Boston in May and June of 1915.

The letter p next to the box number indicates phantom box.
