

FIRE REPORT
CHIEF OF DISTRICT 9

I responded from.... dist.ndqtrs. Alarm 4th - Box 1521
in.... dept. auto. and found Time 10:24 A.M.
... deputy chief MacMonough in command Location 17 Piedmont Street
I reached the fire in.... about 5 minutes Boston November 28, 1942
on arrival reported to Deputy MacMonough on Piedmont Street side of bldg.
directed the operations of Eng. Cos. 3-20-15-43-5 in stretching their
lines into the bldg. via the door openings.

Later directed the work of laddermen in opening up the roof.
Later directed the stretching and operating of lines by Eng. Cos. 16-18
over ladders on Broadway side into adjoining bldg.

After bulk of fire had been extinguished assisted in directing the
removal of bodies from fire area.

Worked under orders of Chief of Dept. Samuel J. O'ope
relieved by Chief O'ope and returned to dist.'s quarters.
Returned to our own quarters on receipt of "all-out" from Box 1521
