FURTHER REMARKS

Being informed of this fire by some member of the department that "another fire on Broadway" went on foot to the above fire. Upon arrival thereat was informed by Dist. Chief Crowley that many persons were trapped. Ordered third and fourth alarms. Later contacted Deputy Chief McDonough and informed him of my actions and took charge of operations upon the Broadway and Shawmut Street sides. Directed in the placing of companies, in placing lines, extinguishment of fire and the removal of persons or bodies from the premises; ordered to quarters by Chief of Department.
