REMARKS

Lt. Alther present detail Eng. 53. M.O.P. Manning present detail Eng. 23. Lad'n. Mc Gowan present detail Lad. 23. Hos'n. Johnson wore gas mask. Line was run from Eng. 15 Wagon. Raised 30' ladder, did axe, rake duty and overhauling on first floor. Removed about 35 bodies from first floor and balcony. Company returned to the quarters of Eng. Co. 3 by orders of Chief of department Pope. Arrived at Eng. Co. 3 at 2.20 A.M. Nov. 29, 1942. Remained there until relieved by Eng. Co. 3 at 3.48 A.M. On duty at Eng. Co. 3 quarters 1 hour and 22 minutes. Returned to Eng. Co. 12 quarters at 3.45 A.M. Engine Co. 12 responded to this box on the third alarm which was sounded at 10.23 P.M.
