RETIRES ON PENSION.

Capt James H. Dooley Has Been Boston Fireman for More Than 25 Years.

Capt James H. Dooley, 37 years a fireman, and for more than 25 years a member of the Boston department, was retired yesterday on a pension. He began his experience as a fireman in 1871 as a member of Butcher Boy hand engine company, Brighton. He became call member of ladder 11, Brighton, in 1880, and became call captain three years later, retaining the position till 1895, when he became master carpenter, a permanent captain taking charge of the ladder company. Capt Dooley is 58 years old.
