

Captain Patrick W. Lanegan, age 49, Ladder Company 13

On March 12, 1910, Captain Lanegan died at 1945 hours from injuries received when he was hit by falling walls on Boston Elevated Railway property at 439 Albany St., South End. 4 Alarms from Box 711 were transmitted at 1356, 1359, 1402, and 1420 hours for Boston Elevated Railway property on Harrison Avenue. Captain Lanegan was leaving the roof area after making sure that all his men had cleared the roof. Several other members were injured, one severely. Captain Lanegan had 21 years of service.
