Responded on 4th alarm to qtrs. of Engine 8. Arr. at 10:29 P.M. Rec'd. 5th alarm at 11:04 P.M. responded to fire. Arr. at 11:10 P.M. Ran 300 ft. 2 1/2" hose from High Pressure Hydrant #22. to 2nd & 3rd floor at 6 Shawmut St. over 20ft. & 50ft. ladders. Passed water 2 hours at intervals. Duties were Rescue, axe and rake duties. Ordered to & returned to qtrs. via Eng. 8 at 1:57 A.M., in qtrs. at 2:05 A.M. Eng. 20 ran 300ft. 2 1/2 in. hose from Eng. 50. Lt. Brocks & Hosta. Powers equipped with gas masks.
