I report, a detail has been maintained constantly at premises No. 15-17 Piedmont Street since Sunday Nov. 29, 1942 and a diligent search has been conducted so as to assure there was no bodies left on premises.

Debris has been overhauled within the building and every nook and corner searched.

A search was made at building exterior, neighboring yards alleys, parked cars looked into and roof survey made . A detail of police assisted this search , considerable number of articles such as jewelry, key cases, ear rings, bill folds, etc. that might serve as a means of identification were recovered and placed in charge of police.

In my opinion further search will be of no avail .
