**GENERAL ORDER No. 49.**

1. MERITORIOUS ACTS — 1924.

The Board of Merit for 1924 has submitted the following report and recommendations to the Fire Commissioner. The Board comprised

The medals and merit bars recommended were awarded at the Fire Commissioner's office on October 13, 1925.

3. While engaged in fighting a fire at Box 1246, July 19, 1924, Commercial Wharf, Ladderman John J. Brown of Ladder Company 8 was knocked overboard while operating a stream from a small boat. Ladderman Brown was unable to swim and was in danger of being drowned, when Ladderman Carl V. Anderson of Ladder Company 8, fully clothed, dove into the water and was of invaluable assistance in rescuing Ladderman Brown.

For this meritorious conduct the name of Ladderman Carl V. Anderson of Ladder Company 8 is placed on the Roll of Merit.
