THE company numbers forty-three men. They have been called out during the past year to two fires within the limits of the town ; once to fill reservoir at Union Square, and twice to fires out of town. The engine and apparatus are in complete order, having four hundred feet of leading hose fit for service, and about twenty-eight feet of suction hose. We beg leave to suggest to the Committee, that they recommend to the town, in their report, the purchase of a hose-carriage, with hose, to be kept in the vicinity of the hydrants.
