

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SELECTMEN:

Gentlemen: We herewith present to you our annual re-

port for the year ending Jan. 31st, 1892, together with a record of fires and losses. The department has responded to eighteen alarms the past year, and, owing to the promptness in answering these

alarms, the town has been saved from serious losses.

Last year we recommended the addition of more hydrants, and we would respectfully call your attention to the matter again this year. We consider this to be a very important subject, as many parts of our town would suffer serious loss in case of fire owing to the long distance from water supply,

and we earnestly hope that an article will be placed in next warrant to see if town will vote to contract for fifty or sixty more hydrants, provided a reasonable figure can be obtained from the Water Company for same. The apparatus is all in good condition, except Hose Co. No. 1 Reel, which is not fit for much further use, and we

have contracted with the Abbott Downing Company to build

a Hose Wagon to take place of No. 1 Reel, to be delivered about May 1st. The Fire Alarm has given perfect satisfaction, and we feel that this branch of our department is second to none, as it has done its work perfectly, owing to the care and attention given it by E. A. Hawley as Superintendent.
