Selectmen's Report.

Table showing Selectmen's Report: New Engine for No. 2 889 00; New Engine for No. 1 750 00; New Hose 218 75; Expenses of Fire Department 2742 05; Reservoir, Mt. Pleasant 322 50; New Engine House & land J. Plain 1348 25.

The ordinary expenses of the Fire Department the past year, has been 2742 05, expending over the appropriation, 242 05. In addition to the above, the sum of 889 00 was raised to pay for Engine No. 2 purchased the year previous; also the expense of Engine No. 1 which cost 750 00, and 300 feet of Hose for said company, which cost 218 75. To meet these two last charges the two old engines were sold, amounting to 715 00, making the excess over and above all the appropriations of the Fire Department 495 80. It is presumed that all the Engines, from the manner in which they have been purchased, are now satisfactory to the several companies belonging to the Fire Department, and the prompt and energetic manner in which they have been worked and managed by the officers and members of the whole department, is highly creditable and satisfactory to the Town.
