

Fire Fighter Bernard G. Tully, age 39, Engine Company 30

On January 22, 1974, Fire Fighter Tully died of injuries he received when the Engine and a garbage truck collided on a very icy morning while responding to a Still Alarm on Centre Street, near Buchanan Road at approximately 0700 hours. Several other firefighters were severely injured. The apparatus chauffeur, John Kraft, never returned to work. The 1968 Ward LaFrance pumper was also heavily damaged and remained out of service for many months. Fire Fighter Tully had 7 years of service.
