FINEST IN DEPARTMENT.

Fire Station at Warren Av and Clarendon St Will Soon Be Completed.



NEW FIRE STATION 22, WARREN AV AND CLARENDON ST.

On the eastern side of Warren av, just south of Clarendon st, the new, double. apparatus station for the Boston fire department is receiving its finishing touches.

This station was erected at an approximate cost of \$20,000, and when ready for occupancy it can properly be called the best-fitted house in the entire

fire department. li has an exterior of fine faced brick, with heavy granite pillars and trim-mings, while the interior will be finished or, three floors in whitewood, and the department on the first floor, to be occupied by the apparatus, in ornamental sheathings and glazed brick. Upon the ground floor will be the appartus, with four stalls in the rear. The second floor will be devoted to lavatories, bathrooms, tollets and lockers' officers' rooms and a large storage room. The third floor will be set aside for a gymnasium, a billiard and smok-

for a gymnasium, a billiard and smoking room and officers' quarters.

Upon the roof a garden will be let,
where in the hot months officers and
men may seek the cooling breezes.

This new station will be known as
"22," and the company and apparatus
now at "headquarters," but formerly
stationed on Darimouth st, before the N
Y, N H & H RR widening, their system
destroyed the old station will be housed
there with an additional company, to
be chosen in the future. be chosen in the future.
