To the Honorable Mayor and Aldermen:

GENTLEMEN:

In conformity with Section 8th of the Fire Ordinance, I herewith lay before your Honorable Board, a list of Officers and Members attached to the Boston Fire Department, with their ages and residences; also the Apparatus under their charge, and its condition, the number of fires the past year, the Hydrants, Reservoirs, and other resources from which water can be obtained in case of fire, also the Fire Ordinance, and Rules and Regulations of the Department.

The department has been called out during the year ending on the thirty-first day of August, one hundred and sixty-seven times. #409. 353

The amount of Loss by fire as far as can be ascertained, is \$400,000 the Insurance on the same \$278,250.

The Engines and Apparatus are all in good order, and the department are prompt and efficient. The Engine Houses are all in good order, except Hook and Ladder House, No. 2.

The past year the Steam Fire Engine, Miles Greenwood, has been brought into service three times, but has not given me that satisfaction I should wish. At present, she is at the machine shop of Messrs. Hinkley & Drury, undergoing some alterations under the superintendence of Mr. Latta, the builder, and in a short time, will be ready for service, when I hope she will prove a valuable auxiliary to the department. A House is being built in the City Stables Yard, on Harrison Avenue, for her reception.
