II. BOARD OF MERIT.

1. The Board of Merit of the Boston Fire Department comprising the Chief of Department and six Deputy Chiefs met during the month of May to consider any acts that had been referred to it by the Fire Commissioner. After consideration the board submitted the following recommendations which are hereby approved by the Fire Commissioner:

a. That Ladderman Martin A. Kenealy of Ladder Company 13 is specially commended for his action on January 5, 1932 in effecting the rescue of a lodger who was trapped on the fourth floor at the building 348 Shawmut Avenue.

b. That the name of Hoseman John A. O'Connor of Engine Company 22 be placed on the Roll of Merit of the Boston Fire Department because of the splendid courage and excellent judgment displayed by him capturing a man who had participated in an armed holdup at 597-A Tremont Street on September 7th, 1932. Hoseman O'Connor is also granted seven days additional vacation for this meritorious service.
