ROUTE OF PARADE, SUNDAY, JUNE 11, 1944

Formation at 9:15 A. M., June 11, 1944, at Fire Headquarters, Bristol Street
START at 9:30 A. M. over the following route:

Bristol Street to Harrison Avenue, to Dover Street, to Tremont Street, to Appleton Street, to Berkeley Street, to Warren Avenue, to Dartmouth Street, to Tremont Street, to Lenox Street

Enter Street Cars and proceed to Arborway Station, Boston Elevated
Reform at Arborway Station and march Washington Street, to Morton Street, to FOREST HILLS CEMETERY, to the FIREMEN'S LOT
