

Among the Firemen. January 30, 1883

A large Turkey morocco-bound Bible was presented to Captain Edwin H. Sawyer of Hook and Ladder Company 12 by Chief William H. Green this morning. On the first page appears the following:

Presented to Captain Edwin H. Sawyer of Hook and Ladder Company No. 12, by Chief Engineer William H. Green in behalf of a lady who admires noble courage. This act was prompted by the services of Captain Sawyer in rescuing Peter Bannon from the flames of a burning building, January 20, 1883.

Chief Green speaks in the highest terms of Captain Sawyer, of his courage in cases of great danger.

The fire commissioners this morning appointed N. S. Bradley permanent hoseman on Engine 22. Captain Edwin Sawyer of Hook and Ladder 12, who recovered the body of Peter Banner, burned to death in the late stable fire near Shawmut avenue, at the risk of his own life, in recognition of his meritorious act his name has been entered on the roll of merit.
