

Lieutenant John M. McLaughlin, Ladder Company 19

Lieutenant McLaughlin died from injuries received while working at a fire, Box 7323, 1929 hours, at 539 East First Street on January 16, 1928. An annual annuity was approved by Mayor Malcolm Nichols of \$600 for Lieutenant McLaughlin's widow, Kathleen McLaughlin.
