On October 22, 1946, Hoseman Barnard and Hoseman Cady died, and Lieutenant Flahive was severely injured, from the inhalation of smoke and poison gases from burning fur in the basement of Kakas Furs, 70-72 Chauncy Street, Downtown, Box 1463, (Chauncy Street and Rowe Place), at 1707 hours. Hoseman Barnard had 4 years and Hoseman Cady had 10 months of service.

\* Lieutenant Flahive was hospitalized for a period of time before being discharged. Due to his injuries, he never returned to duty. He died on March 6, 1974, at age 67.
